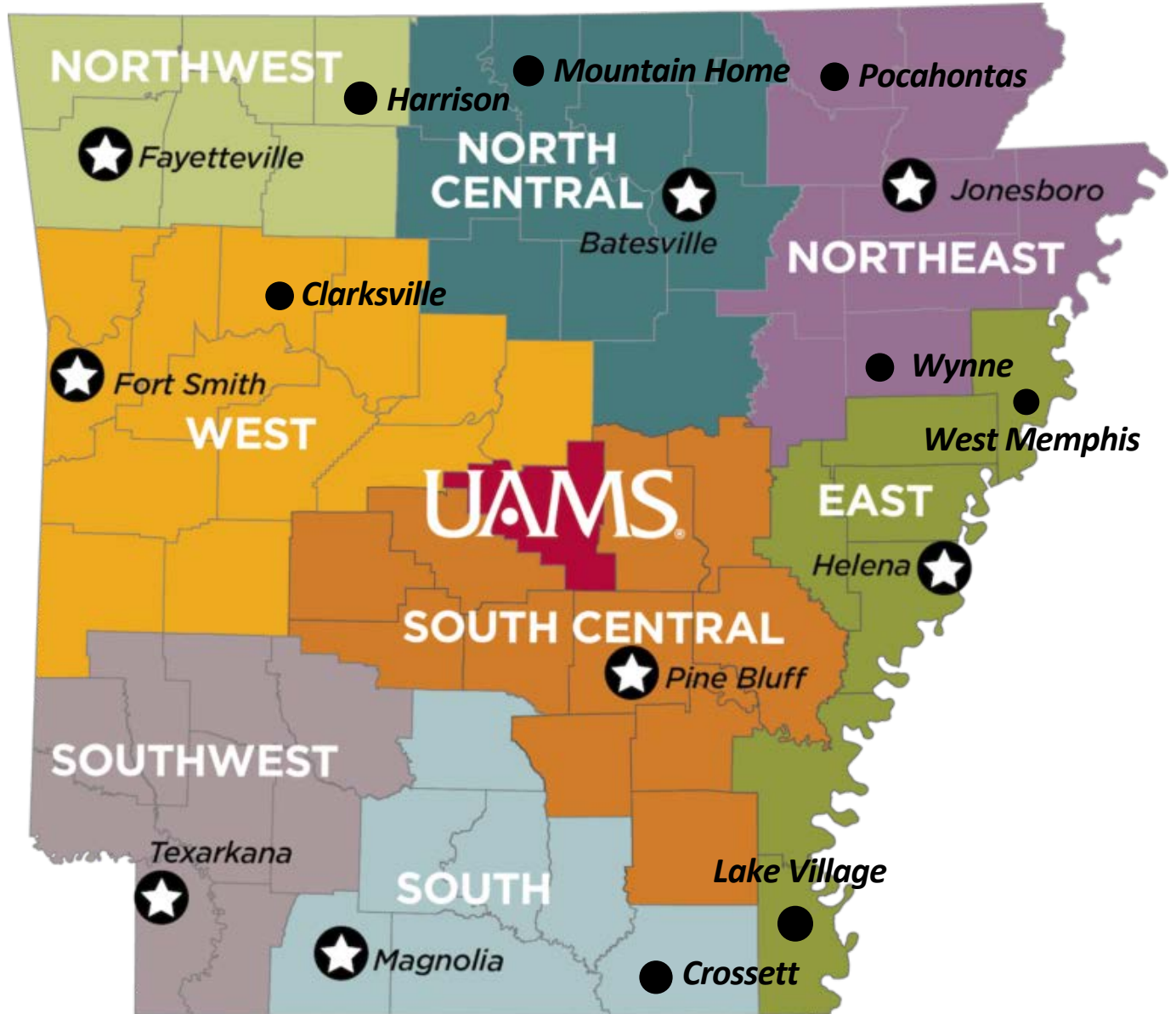
### CONTACT US
